- Hakko Soldering Iron
- Heat Gun
- Hot Glue gun
- Embossing Iron

Before Use

- Check in with Steam Central Staff Member
- Inspect all equipment. Do not use equipment that has obvious damage to body, cable, or plug.
- Keep work area clear of electrical cords to prevent damage from heated tip.
- Use proper stands to insure the work surface is not damaged by heat.

During Use

- Never touch the hot end of the tool. Some of these tools can heat up to 800° or more.
- Ensure that you have a good grip on tools during use.
- Wear safety glasses when using soldering iron as the solder can pop on occasion.
- Use clamps or gloves to hold item that is being applied heat. If using Soldering Iron, use the helping hand provided.
- While using soldering iron, always keep the sponge wet during use.
- Never solder a live circuit.
- Keep face away from object when heating as materials can produce fumes.
- Never point heat gun towards anyone.
- Never leave heated tool on and touching work surface. This can start a fire.
- Never try to catch a heated tool if it falls.
- Let surface you are heating cool down before touching.

After Use

- Always return tool to its stand when not in use
- When finished with heated tools turn off or unplug them immediately.
- Always clean work area when finished.
- Before leaving check work area for any tools that may have been left out and notify staff member.
