

## Janome Magnolia 7330 Sewing Machine Policy

There are few libraries in the United States that offer free access to sewing machines--your library is one! We need your help to keep this machine accessible to everyone in the community. The Janome sewing machines have a retail value of \$300. If the machine is damaged beyond the budget to repair it no one will have the privilege of using the machine.

We require re-certification of patrons who improperly use the machine, do not follow the policies and procedures set forth to prevent damage to the machine, and repeatedly make mistakes that cause unnecessary wear and damage to the machine. We may ban patrons from use of the machine if problems persist after re-certification.

### Age Restrictions

- 13 and older after certification.
- 9 and older after completing the certification class, with adult supervision.

### Consumables needed (and restrictions)

Patrons must provide their own consumable materials, including thread and fabric. In order to keep this machine in top working order, restrictions on brands and types of materials may apply, and all materials must be checked by STEAM Central Staff to insure they will work in the machine.

- Thread –**Never use old thread or hand sewing thread**, as this will ruin the machine and your project.
- Bobbins--STEAM Central provides bobbins for use in the space. If you wish to keep the remaining bobbin thread, you may bring in your own Janome J style bobbin.
- Feet—STEAM Central provides an Automatic Buttonhole Foot, Satin Stitch Foot F, Zig-Zag Foot, Walking foot, Quarter Inch Foot, and Zipper Foot (screw on). ### Before Use

- The sewing machine requires a certification class and appointment before use.
- Alert staff if you notice damage or the machine is not working properly.

### During Use

- Keep fingers away from all moving parts and needles.
- If the needle is bent or damaged during sewing, alert staff so that the needle can be changed.

### After use

- Turn off the machine and remove your thread and bobbin.
- Replace the cover and unplug the machine.
- Return all equipment to Staff.
