Bicycle Lending Policy

Approved by Board of Trustees: July 2018

In support of recreation and fitness, the Jacob Edwards Library has provided some bicycles for the community to enjoy, and to expand library services. The bicycles are available seasonally; weather permitting from May through October.

- Valid library card and photo ID required for check out.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Only one bicycle may be borrowed per card.
- Bicycle may only be used by the person who borrowed the bicycle and signed the *Bicycle Borrower Agreement*.
- The bicycle may only be operated during daylight hours.
- Must wear the Jacob Edwards Library helmet supplied.
- Sign and date the Bicycle Borrower Agreement.
- The library has 3 bicycles of different sizes to lend. The bikes come with helmets and locks.
- The bicycles are loaned for one day at a time only and are due for return 30 minutes prior to closing on the day they were borrowed.
- Southbridge residents may reserve a bicycle in advance.
- The library has the right not to lend a bicycle to a person if there are safety concerns.
