- 1<sup>st</sup> That Mrs. Helen Stanley be Elected Librarian, and that we pay her a salary of one thousand (\$1000) Dollars per year, or at that rate for such portion of the year as she may serve. Such salary to pay for her own services, and the services of all assistants and janitor, and to cover the expensing of all card and numerical catalogues, and a catalogue of all the books purchased during the year ready for publication, and all other labor connected with the library.
- 2<sup>d</sup> That Mrs. Stanley be allowed to give her services at such time as she may judge best for the interest of our institution.
- 3<sup>d</sup> That until Mrs. Stanley takes charge that the library be under the care and direction of Geo. M. Lovell, with power to hire such assistants as he may judge best, the expense thereof not to exceed the rate of salary voted to Mrs. Stanley.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That the salary of Librarian, be paid monthly, in the future.
- 5<sup>th</sup> That the report of Secretary as read be approved, and published as the annual report of the Committee.

6th. That the Board be asked for an appropriation of \$1500. and the way found for the ensuing year.

7th That the reports of all additions to the library be published and furnished to the Librarian for free deposit.

8th That the meeting be dissolved
