The regular meeting of the Library committee was called to order at 8.05 p.m. There were present Messrs. Corbin, Morrill, Earls, Hebert and Whittaker.

The records of previous meetings of Nov. 1906 and Jan. 1907 were read and approved.

The librarian's report was read and accepted and it was voted that the same be printed as the report of the Committee.

Voted to ask the town for an appropriation of \$1700 and the dog fund in order to pay expenses for the coming year.

Miss Ella E. Miersch was elected librarian and Miss Mabel W. Plimpton assistant librarian for 1907 at the same salaries as for 1906. John Coggins was elected to serve as janitor at a salary of \$100.

The Library committee reported concerning the painting and kalsomining of the library rooms that R. Wardle, the lowest bidder, was to do the work. This report was accepted.

Voted to adjourn at 8.35 p.m.
