## THE "THREE-LEGGED STOOL" OF LIBRARY VOLUNTEER SUPPORT:

Board of Library Trustees (BoLT), The Library Foundation, and Friends of the Wareham Free Library

The **Board of Library Trustees** is one of the three groups whose primary function is the support and maintenance of the library for the Wareham community.

**BoLT** members have no fiduciary responsibilities, but oversee the library director and library policies. They promote the long term sustainability of the library and are a conduit for community library concerns and needs. They are appointed by the Board of Selectmen to serve three year terms. The trustees are considered unpaid town employees. There is a Board of Selectmen representative appointed to the BoLT as a liaison to ensure coordination and cooperation in the achievement of the town's and library's goals.

The **Friends** of the Library is a voluntary organization with many members who raise money thru many used book sales. The money is used to buy books and supplies that that go beyond the library's budget.

The **Foundation** is a smaller volunteer group that raises money from grants and programs for capital expenses and other large ticket items.
