

Library Code of Conduct

There shall be no more than one person per chair. No sitting or lying on tables or other persons. No lying on the floor.

Smoking is prohibited in the Library.

No swearing, profanity, loud talking, or yelling is allowed.

No electronic viewing or listening devices are permitted without earphones, and volume must be kept low.

Persons are prohibited from loitering on the Library premises in a manner which interferes with the normal activities of Library patrons or staff, or which blocks or obstructs doorways, hallways, passages, aisles, sidewalks, driveways or the parking lot.

Running in the building or in and out of the building is prohibited.

Parents, or adults accompanying young children, are responsible for picking up after them, and should remain with them at all times.

Book bags, knapsacks, skateboards, roller blades and roller skates are to be checked at the circulation desk.

The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of these items.

Skateboarding is prohibited on Library premises.

Persons abusing the above guidelines may be asked to leave. Persons refusing to leave or who have been ejected for repeated offenses may be banned from the premises. Persons banned from the premises who enter the Library without express written permission from the Library Director or an authorized representative may be prosecuted in any appropriate manner authorized by law.
